Before becoming the most popular novelists ever seen before
With her first publication a century ago
In 1920 being 'The Mysterious Affair at Styles' involving Hercule Poirot
- 3) Agatha married Archibald Christie 1914 until 1928
Though after having one child called Rosalind Hicks they divorced at a later date
In 1930 until 1976 she was to marry archaeologist Max Mallowan though
And as-well as tour with him she'd have a lot more books to everyone show
- 4) Agatha was to publish plenty a Hercule Poirot and Miss Marple story for you and me
At a later date to be seen as detective stories on TV
Her play 'The Mousetrap' was shown at the London theatre in 1952
Which has been performed again and again, with no break, to be seen by oh quite a few
- 5) In regard of everything she had done
Agatha was appointed 'Dame Commander Of The British Empire' in 1971
Then on the 12th January 1976 in Winterbrook sadly she did die
