- 1) Rob Burrow was born, in Yorkshire, on the 26th September 1982
Later to become a person known well sport-wise by me and you
Playing as an English professional rugby league footballer for ages
And as a top-class scrum-half or hooker making all the front pages
- 2) For 16 years Rob played with Leeds Rhinos in the Super League yes
Winning a total of 8 championships or so I guess
Achieving 2 Challenge Cups in his career too
Being known as 'the smallest player in super league' by oh quite a few
- 3) Rob played for England and Great Britain a bit as-well
Named to the Super League Dream Team in what time had to tell
Also having Lindsey Burrow as his long-term loyal wife
Bringing up 3 children in their complete family life
- 4) Then Rob was diagnosed with motor neurone disease (MND) in December 2019
And him to become extremely very unhealthy was unfortunately to be seen
But with colleague Kevin Sinfield for this disease MND he fund-raised a real lot
Which meant each of them a valued CBE award deservedly got
- 5) Rob, as a 41 year old ex-sportsman, who lots of people got to adore
In Pinderfields Hospital, Wakefield sadly died on the 2nd June 2024
Yet he will certainly be remembered forever
